Cutting Edge Zero Energy Home Design

LAKESWOOD, Colo.-- In 2005 the University of Colorado (CU) team made headlines with a first place finish in the 2005 Solar Decathlon for their solar home, BioS(h)IP. On August 1st homeowners can learn about the details of this home in a workshop taught by Jeffrey Lyng, Project Manager of the winning house.

This workshop will showcase what sets this solar home apart from the competition. By integrating green building with solar power this home presents the best in sustainable living. Jeff will present an overview of the Solar Decathlon competition, describe the CU Bio-S(h)IP in detail (including its energy systems and bio-based materials) and outline the CU team's approach to Zero Energy Home design. Jeff will also reveal the key strategies that the team employed to win the competition and their implications for future energy usage in homes.
